The following initial offer has been received from the delegation of Slovenia on 12 June with the request that it be circulated to Members of the Council for Trade in Services.

Attached is an initial offer of the Republic of Slovenia in the context of the negotiation based on GATS Art. XIX and the paragraph 15 of the Doha Ministerial Declaration dated 14 November 2001, to be circulated to all Members of the Council for Trade in Services.

The Republic of Slovenia reserves the right to modify, reduce or withdraw its initial offer on services and any subsequent offer that could follow. The Republic of Slovenia further reserves the right to make any technical change or correction to this initial offer and any subsequent offer that could follow.
