Corrigendum

The following correction should be made to document TN/RL/GEN/77:

"On page 2, the proposed new text for article 6.1.1 should read:

6.1.1 <u>The authorities shall send to all known</u> exporters or foreign producers receiving questionnaires used in an anti-dumping investigation <u>and they</u> shall be given at least 30 days for reply.² Due consideration should be given to any request for an extension of the 30-day period and, upon cause shown, such an extension should be granted whenever practicable."

 $^{^{2}}$ As a general rule, the time-limit for exporters shall be counted from the date of receipt of the questionnaire, which for this purpose shall be deemed to have been received one week from the date on which it was sent to the respondent or <u>received by</u> transmitted to the appropriate diplomatic representative of the exporting Member or, in the case of a separate customs territory Member of the WTO, an official representative of the exporting territory.
