Communication from Egypt

Corrigendum

The second paragraph on Page 2 of Document TN/RL/GEN/122 under **Introduction of factors for the determination of “*material retardation*”** should read as follows:

Egypt believes that the proposed list of factors that investigating authorities may consider should include: (i) capacity utilisation; (ii) delays in the start of reasonable commercial production; and (iii) the amount of domestic production as compared to the size of the domestic market. Egypt is convinced that the examination of the above-mentioned factors provide useful signal to investigating authorities in determining whether the establishment of a domestic industry is materially retarded.
