Page 2, paragraph 3

The following sub-paragraph should be inserted after sub-paragraph (d):

(e) Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, Ecuador, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Mexico, Paraguay, Peru and Uruguay jointly recommend that "an assessment should be made of the desirability of establishing a mechanism to organize and coordinate technical assistance and capacity building in the area of trade facilitation, pooling the efforts of donors, recipients and other international organizations. This mechanism would ensure that technical assistance is adapted to the needs of the recipients, so as to guarantee transparency, coherence and effective assistance to developing and least developed countries in the implementation of commitments in this field" (TN/TF/W/41).
