## Corrigendum

- 1. Paragraph 12 should read as follows:
  - "12. Natural gas has been recognized in the Kyoto Protocol negotiations as part of the solution to stabilize greenhouse gases in the atmosphere, Decision -/CP.7 of the Marrakesh Accords on the implementation of articles 4.8 and 4.9 of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) and articles 2.3 and 3.14 of the Kyoto Protocol states in paragraph 31 "Encourages Annex II Parties to promote investment in, and to support and cooperate with, developing country parties in the development, production, distribution and transport of indigenous, less greenhouse gas emitting, environmentally sound, energy sources including natural gas, according to the natural circumstances of each of these parties" (The Marrakesh Accords and the Marrakesh Declaration, UNFCCC.int/COP7/documents/Accords\_draft). The IPCC Assessment Reports have recommended increased use of natural gas over other fossil fuels as a way to reduce greenhouse gas emissions."
