Corrigendum

1. The last sentence of paragraph 2.4 on page 2 of TN/MA/W/42 should be replaced with the following:

"These have also contributed to a lack of coherence to the development and trade policies of developing countries."

2. The second sentence of paragraph 6.1 on page 4 should be replaced with the following:

"Non-tariff barriers such as anti-dumping, technical barriers to trade, and import licensing in developed countries, often pose significant barriers to developing country exports."

3. The last sentence of the column "Sectoral Approach and Zero for Zero" in the table on page 5 should be replaced with the following:

"Developing countries should be allowed a % exclusion and end rate greater than zero".
